**TEMPORARY ORDERS IN RESPONSE TO THE COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS)
PUBLIC HEALTH CRISIS**

Whereas, effective March 14, 2020, the Director of the Ohio Department of Health issued a Director's Order closing all K-12 schools in the state of Ohio, and effective March 20, 2020, the Director issued a Stay at Home Order, the Court implements the following temporary orders:

Effective immediately,

-Pursuant to Section 14.e of the Director's Stay at Home Order, parties should continue to exchange their children as required by their respective parenting plan or custody orders, as the same is deemed Essential Travel.

-With respect to parenting time issues and the state-ordered school closures, parents who have shared parenting plans or custody orders should continue to follow those orders to the best of their abilities and in the spirit intended by the Court.

-Parties should adhere to all holiday and spring break schedules as designated by their schools at the beginning of the school year, regardless of recent changes. They should follow the regular parenting schedule during all other times, unless their orders specifically address school closures.


-Parties should communicate with regard to the location, health and welfare of their children and should discuss any travel plans and arrangements as required by their respective parenting plan or custody order.

The Court will evaluate the status of the COVID-19 epidemic and ascertain the necessity for further orders.




